

# T for TRUFFLE

Sometimes you only have to mention them for gourmets to rejoice. Their name alone evokes incomparable flavours of hazelnuts and undergrowth. The Burgundian truffle is not only an incredible autumn mushroom, it is also a regional treasure that has remained in the shadows for far too long. The first truffle to be invited to the dinner tables of the Kings of France, Tuber Uncinatum has, several centuries later, fallen out of favour. But that is to fail to take into account the determination and enthusiasm of Burgundy's truffle industry.

# **⊙ MIGENNES AND IT'S RAILWAY QUARTER:** A MODEL WORKER'S VILLAGE

A typical example of a 'town within a town', constructed at the height of the industrial revolution, the **Cité de Migennes Quarter** can be strolled around. Discover the daily life of the inhabitants from the days of steam and see their communal buildings – including the apprentices centre, private school, dispensary, school of domestic science, a chapel and even an independent commercial distribution network – all of which were set up by the Paris-Lyon-Méditerranée Railway Company in the 19th century.

**DON'T MISS** the famous roundhouses, constructed at the end of the 19<sup>th</sup> century and early 20<sup>th</sup> century, some of which have up to 45 tracks. They are emblematic of this vast railway complex dedicated to steam.



# 'POINTS NOEUDS', a small revolution in the cycling world

Three questions for Philippe LEBUGLE, Director of Doubs Tourisme

### **ee** What are 'Points Noeuds'?

They're a waymarking system inspired by the signs found in the mines in the 19<sup>th</sup> century. The principle's simple: an area is covered with a grid and we place a signpost at each crossroads, or 'Point Noeud' so that cyclists can work out where they are. The number on the sign indicates which section of the grid they are currently on and which they can join next. With 'Points Noeuds' all our route planning habits change!

# What are the advantages of 'Points Noeuds'?

The 'Points Noeuds' system is very easy to use and also offers users complete freedom. Cyclists can create a route in advance depending on where they want to go and how fit they are. They can also change it as they go, without having to double back on themselves.

# Where can you use the 'Points Noeuds' system?

There are two areas where we've installed 850 signs across nearly 310 miles so you can explore them the 'Points Noeuds' way. They're in the heart of Haut-Doubs, where we've got 53 'Points Noeuds' and the area between the Ognon Valley and Doubs, where there are 130 'Points Noeuds'. 





# Why has Dole chosen to highlight food?
