SAINTE-MARIE-MADELEINE **BASILICA OF VÉZELAY**

Vézelay Abbey stands on top of the eternal hill, as it is known, as a symbol of human devotion through the ages. Each year, its spiritual luminosity is admired by thousands of awestruck visitors and pilgrims following the Way of St James. This Romanesque work of art houses an abundance of carvings on its tympanums, capitals, doorways and other features... a remarkable and highly original ensemble!



chapel is more than a mere site of pilgrimage to the Virgin Mary. Le Corbusier's work of architectural art transcends religion to become an inspirational and moving symbol of innovation. Two other architects of international fame have since displayed their talents on Ronchamp hill: Jean Prouvé in 1975 and Renzo Piano in 2011.



THE CHAPEL'S SECOND YOUTH

The site of Ronchamp Hill has been extremely busy since the first renovation work began here in 2022. The chapel will look like new again by the end of 2024!

A WORLD-UNIOUF PHENOMENON

Some 900 years ago, the builders achieved an amazing feat with all those windows! Each year during the summer and winter solstice, the sun creates sublime paths of light of geometrical perfection in the nave.

The basilica's restoration began in 2014 and is ongoing. After the radiating chapel, the chancel, the transepts, the Saint-Antoine tower, the west facade and the narthex, it is now the turn of the nave and the side aisles to be renovated. This work is due to end in 2025-26. But don't worry, the basilica remains open to visitors throughout the duration of the work!

THE VAUBAN CITADEL AND **FORTIFICATIONS IN BESANÇON**

Power incarnate... This impressive fortress towering above the city of Besançon and blending into the relief, is an outstanding example of 17th-century military architecture. It is the showpiece of the Vauban fortifications, deemed to be one of the most

beautiful in France.

After 15 years of discussion and 3 years of work, the

Resistance and Deportation Museum has finally

unveiled its new, completely redesigned permanent tour, packed with new star items. It also features a temporary exhibition area and at last puts on public display one of its treasures, one of Europe's richest collections of deportation art.

Le Jardin de Vauban, is a new exhibition area, the first in a fabulous series, that visitors approach like a history book. A place where nature, biodiversity and the past come magnificently together.


New name, new decor and a new concept for the Citadelle restaurant: Open daily, the **Momentum** serves a seasonal menu that gives pride of place to fresh produce.

FROM THE GREAT SALTWORKS OF SALINS-LES-BAINS TO THE ROYAL SALTWORKS OF ARC-ET-SENANS.

two outstandingly valuable structures that bear witness to the glory days of salt... An ancient story that takes its roots in the subsoil of Salins-les-Bains where the Great Saltworks exploited the white gold from the Middle ages until 1962. Bearing witness to this unique activity is a 13th-century underground passage of 165 metres in length, featuring a wheel with a huge 19th-century wooden pendulum, still in operation, and the last salt stove still existing in France. With the Age of Enlightenment in full swing, its bigger neighbour, the Royal Saltworks, started up to increase salt production and make up for the lack of wood required by the sector. The project came to fruition on the edge of the Chaux forest, with the architect Claude-Nicolas Ledoux tasked with building a palace of a factory. The rest is a fascinating story, waiting to be discovered at this majestic, illuminated site that continues, even today, to captivate and inspire the modern world.

3D EXPERIENCE AT THE ROYAL SALTWORKS!

Unique in Bourgogne-Franche-Comté, the Centre de Lumières is a new, immersive 3D facility offering an interactive voyage to the four corners of the world. The sphinxes of Egypt, the ancient city of Palmyra, Leptis Magna in Roman Libya, and Venice are among the eight UNESCO-listed sites to be seen here like you've never seen them before!

SAVE THE DATE

It's all happening at the Royal Saltworks in **July & August, in a mix of sound, light and drama...** Three arts staged together in a historical show entitled Lux Salina. A more intimate event, Les Nuits de la Saline, involves a crazy walkabout in the 2nd semi-circle gardens, followed by dinner and a screening of the film 'Mapping' with photographs taken by Vincent Munier.



THE PREHISTORIC PILE DWELLINGS OF THE LAKES OF CHALAIN AND CLAIRVAUX

Of life in these very first fishing and farming villages dating from 5000 to 500 BC, nothing would remain were it not for the incredible conservation properties of the water. Invisible but fascinating evidence of Neolithic life.

'CLIMATS' OF THE BURGUNDY VINEYARD

In this context, a 'climat' is not a weather phenomenon but a wine terroir! Since the 17th century, this term has been applied to specifically named parcels with precise boundaries from which the grapes are harvested and vinified separately to retain their full character. More than 1,500 of these Climats have appeared along the Côte de Beaune and Côte de Nuits hillsides between Dijon and Les Maranges. A fascinating culture of world-unique expertise and remarkable heritage.



A NEW PLACE TO VISIT

In Beaune, the main visitor centre among the **3 devoted to the Climats and wines of Burgundy** has finally opened its doors. Through a scenographic tour enriched with unprecedented multimedia features, the immersion in the history, expertise and heritage of the wines of Burgundy is instant and highly effective. It has an area devoted specifically to the World Heritage site and its components. Naturally, the tour ends with a tasting session. The good news is, there's a tour for children as well!

6 KM OF STONE WALLS RESTORED!

For the past 5 years, a sponsorship programme has made it possible to restore more than 200 wine heritage features: walls, huts, gates, steps... Some amazing ancient structures that in many cases have determined the Climat boundaries and turned the landscape into this highly iconic patchwork.



THE CÔTE-D'OR AND SAÔNE-ET-LOIRE IN THE SPOTLIGHT
